CONSERVATION

Planting and Care of Daffodils

Yes! Conservation will be giving you three daffodil bulbs again this year. When you get home, put them in the refrigerator until December. When you're ready to plant, dig a big hole, eight inches deep. Put a bulb in each corner (point side up), cover it with dirt and step on the hole. Next spring, and every spring after, enjoy a pop of color! Be sure NOT to cut the green parts when it finishes blooming. Those green parts are making the blooms for the following year. If you've been planting the bulbs for the last few years, some of them may be ready to separate. After the green parts have turned brown and are just there on the ground, dig deep and remove the bulbs and then transplant them, following the directions above.

The final collection of completed bags will occur at our November meeting. If you don't sew, but would like to participate in this project, you can help by providing any of the following items that will be included in each patient's Smile Bag:

- Small shampoo (.85 to 1.4 oz size, screw-on top only)
- Small comb (no rat tails)

- New wash cloth
- Bar of soap (small hotel size)
- Travel-sized toothpaste (at least 6 months from expiration date)
- Child-sized toothbrush (single package)
- Small stuffed animal (Beanie Baby® size)
- 8-pack box of non-toxic crayons
- Thin 8.5" x 11" coloring book
- Small square mirror (approximate size 3"x 3")

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

[What would the Georgia Marsy's Law Amendment change?](#)

Amendment 4 was designed to add a Paragraph XXX, a variation of a [Marsy's Law](#), to [Section 1 of Article I](#) of the [Georgia Constitution](#).^[2] The paragraph was written to, upon request, provide crime victims with specific rights, including the right to be treated with fairness, dignity, and respect; the right to notice of all proceedings involving the alleged criminal; the right to be heard at any proceedings involving that release, plea, or sentencing of the accused; and the right to be informed of their rights. The amendment also explicitly stated that the legislature was able to further define, expand, and provide for the enforcement of the rights. The amendment also contains provisions preventing its use to justify a legal action against the state or any state officials, a challenge to a verdict or sentence in a

criminal case, an appeal of any criminal court decision or proceeding, and the ability to be a party in any criminal proceeding beyond what is explicitly allowed by the amendment.


